

Maths Homework 25.09.2020

Below are some hints and resources that might help you.



a)

To work out what the intervals on the thermometer represent, I used trial and error.

I noticed that there are 4 intervals between 0 and 100, so I divided 100 by 4. This means each interval represents 25 degrees.

Siberia

0 °C 25 °C 50 °C 75 °C 100 °C

We can write on all the numbers to help us.

Siberia

-100 °C -75 °C -50 °C -25 °C 0 °C 25 °C 50 °C 75 °C 100 °C

I did it a different way. I know that half-way between 0 and 100 is 50. I also know that the arrow is pointing at a number less than 0, so it must point to -50.

The temperature in the town in Siberia was -50 °C.
