4. When Jane went back into the classroom Sarah was not there. Lucy was sat on a chair at the front next to Mrs Smith.



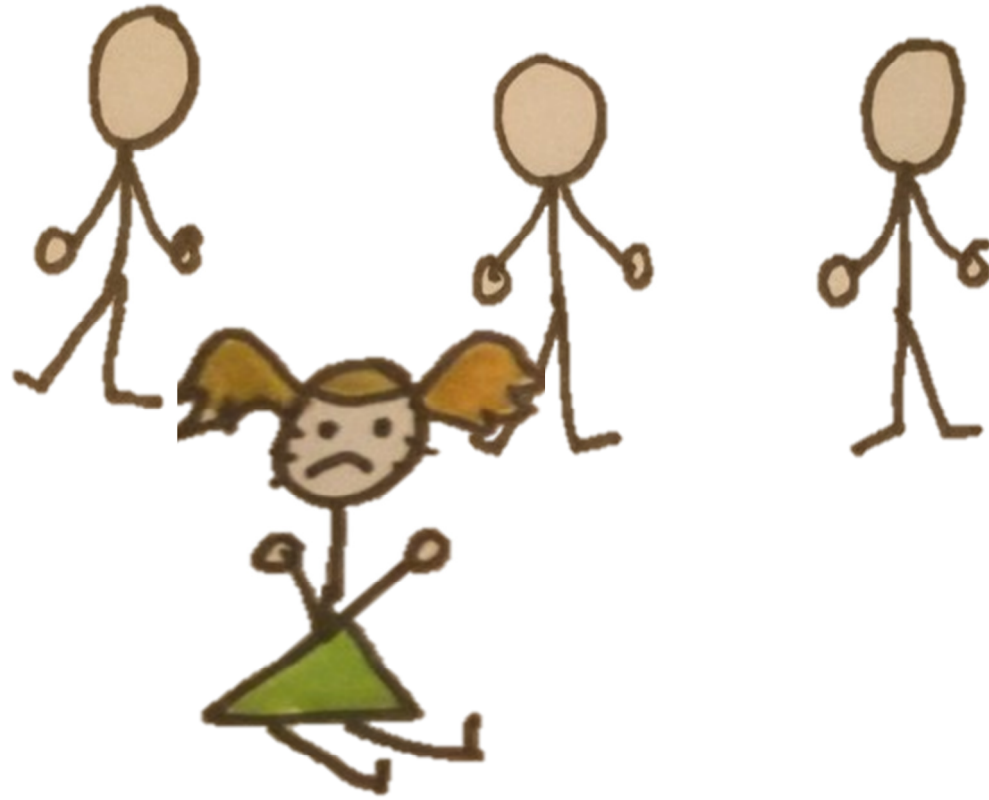

They went to get Mrs Smith.



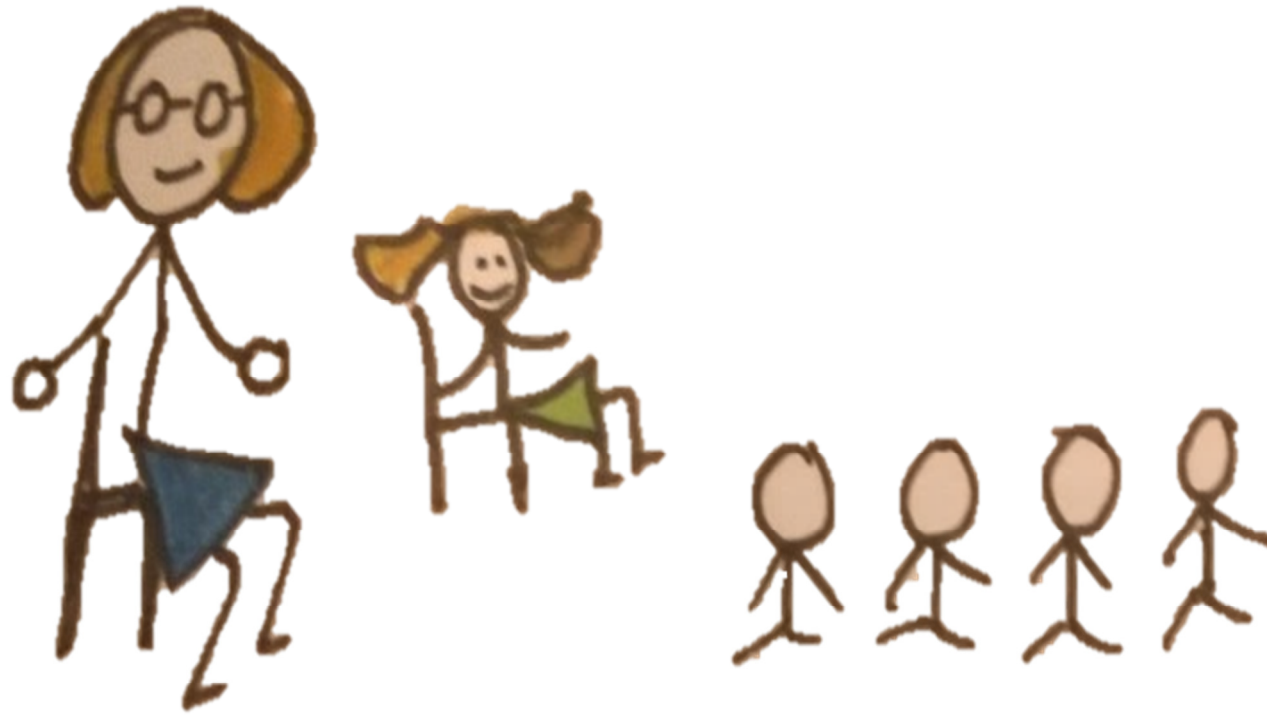
9. Mrs Smith asked her what was the matter and Jane told her that Sarah had pushed her over.
