Nessy Rule

Drop the 'e' where the word ending (tail) starts with a vowel.
Keep the 'e' where the word ending (tail) starts with a consonant.
Remember to treat 'y' as a vowel where it makes a vowel sound.

How to play

1. Lay the answer cards in a line.
2. Shuffle the question cards and lay the pack blue side up.
3. Look at the first word on the question card and place it on an answer card.
4. At the end turn over the questions to self-correct and count your score.
5. Next time try to beat your score and time yourself.
