This lesson introduces advanced, multi-syllable prefixes.

Understanding the meanings of prefixes can help to learn them.

prefix (head)	meaning	example
trans	across	transfer
non	not	nonsense
per	through	percolate
sub	under	subsidiary
mis	bad	misunderstood
anti	against, gives an opposite meaning	antiestablishment antisocial
bi	two	bicycle
ob	against, towards	obstacle
pre	earlier	prehistoric
co	together	co-education

### Lesson Plan

	activity	time
