

Spelling Homework 06.11.2020

In our spelling lessons next week we will be focussing on adding the following suffixes: -ible/-ibly, -able/-ably.

We normally just add the suffix to the root word.

However:

- If the word ends in an e or consonant +y, then the usual rules of dropping the e or changing y to an i apply, e.g. excite > excitable, rely > reliable.
- If the -able ending is added to a word ending in -ce or -ge, the e after the c or g must be kept, as those letters would otherwise have their hard sounds (as in cap and gap) before the a of the -able ending, e.g. change > changeable, notice > noticeable.

Practise adding suffixes to the roots below.

sense	horr	inflate	unmiss
consider	lock	rely	adore
drive	irritate	suit	terr
believe	flex	poss	live
response	laugh	excite	comfort
change	enjoy	divide	notice
