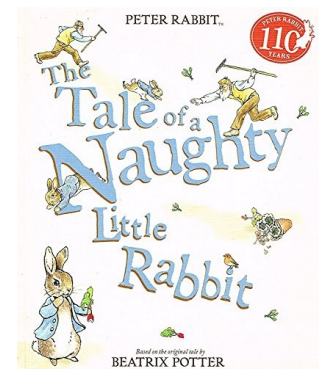
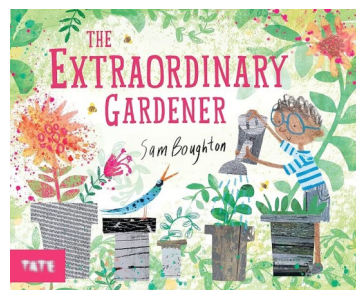
We will continue our Geography topic from last term learning:
