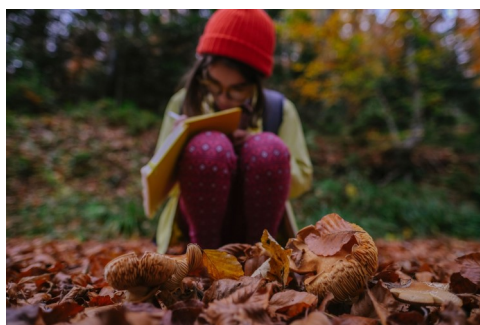
Welcome back!

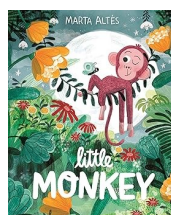
What changes happen in Autumn?

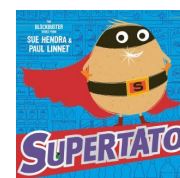


We are Authors



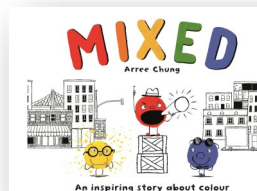
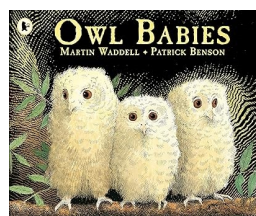
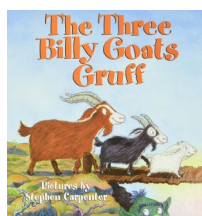
We began by reading Little Monkey who bravely climbed the tallest tree in the jungle. We discussed what things we wanted to achieve this year.

The children will learn to form sentences with the correct punctuation and handwriting as well as to use their phonic knowledge to spell unfamiliar words.



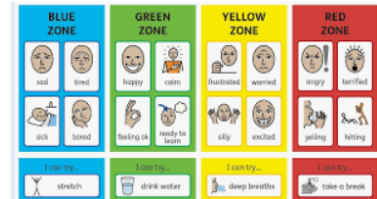
We are mathematicians

- We will be following the same Maths curriculum as the rest of the school but working at the level appropriate to each individual. The year begins by looking at the value of numbers. For some this is counting objects up to ten accurately and for others this is counting in tens across one hundred.
- During Maths Mat activities we will encourage the children to tell us “what they see” and “how they see it” in order to build their reasoning skills.

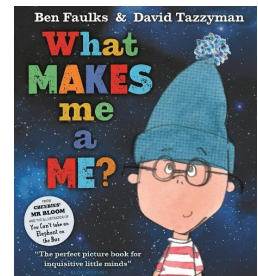


Well-being within the curriculum
