Set A: Test 1

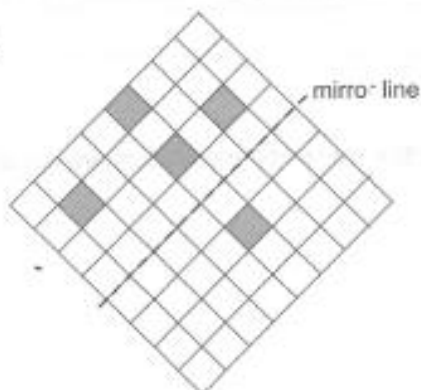
There are **9 questions** in this test. Give yourself **10 minutes** to answer them all.

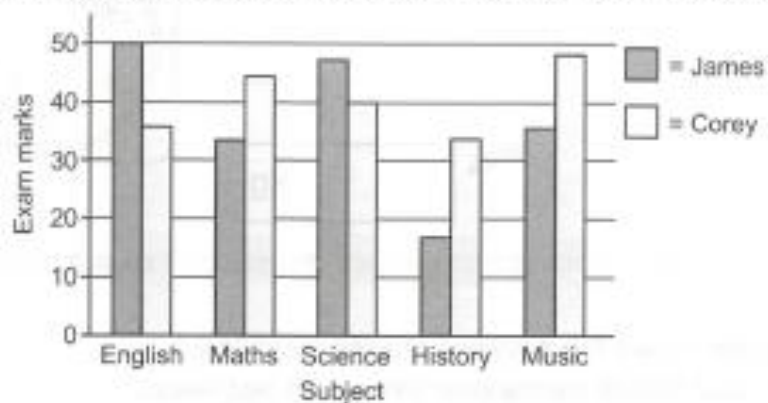
7. Put a circle around the number that is **not** a square number.
