

D **DESCRIPTION**

Describe the setting or character from your story



A **ACTION**

Write about something that is happening

D **DIALOGUE**



Include some speech or dialogue between characters



W **WHERE**



under, through, behind, below, above, on top, across, inside, next to...

A **ADVERB**



angrily, cautiously, silently, suddenly, gently, foolishly, quickly, nervously...

V **VERB**



leaping, trudging, hurrying, crawling, darting, trembling, grinning, sighing...

E **estimation of TIME**



afterwards, immediately, soon, later, after a while, before long, all of a sudden, in a blink of an eye, eventually...

R **RHETORICAL question**



A character thinks of a question that doesn't need an answer.

How did I get into this mess? She thought to herself.

S **SIMILE or METAPHOR**
