

Year 6 Writing Planning

Welcome to your writing lessons for our 2 week bubble closure.

Below you will find your daily tasks.

You should have all of the paper resources printed in your packs but if you have lost anything you can find everything you need under the 'Bubble Closure' tab on our class page on the school website.

The 'Bubble Closure' tab also has other resources you may need such as the video that you will use to inspire your writing during these two weeks.

Day 1	Find the Titanium music video under the 'Bubble Closure' tab on the school website and watch the first minute only! What has happened? What has caused this? Why? In your exercise books write a setting description of the opening scene. Success: • Use the senses – what do you notice? • Fronted adverbial • Expanded noun phrases • Relative clause You will find a modelled write in your packs or on the school website. We look forward to sharing these when we catch up with you this afternoon.
Day 2	Watch the Titanium video all the way through. Story map or bullet point the key events throughout. The layout for a story map is shown on our class page. I wonder if we all include the same events when we share this afternoon?
Day 3	Watch the Titanium video again. You are going to plan a narrative retelling the events in the video. You will find a model narrative and the planning sheet in your packs and on the school website. Choose your favourite section of the plan to share this afternoon.

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Day 4	Today you are going to use your plan to write your narrative of the music video. You can do this in your exercise book or on the computer. Remember to use the modelled write to help you. We would love to see your writing – feel free to ask an adult to take a picture and email it to us or prepare to share this afternoon.
Day 5	Please edit and redraft your narrative from yesterday. Firstly edit all of the spellings by reading backwards and then the punctuation by reading forwards. Choose one paragraph to redraft. Be prepared to share your original paragraph and your redrafted paragraph this afternoon.
Day 6	Re watch the Titanium video. Rewrite your narrative from the point of view of the boy. Use his emotions throughout the story to help the reader understand how he feels. You can do this in your exercise book or on a computer. You will find an example of how to rewrite the story from the point of view of the boy in your pack. Choose your most emotive sentence and be prepared to share it this afternoon.
Day 7	Re watch the Titanium video. Write speech bubbles showing what each of the character might say to the police during an interview after the events in the video. Speech bubbles can be found in your packs or under the 'Bubble Closure' tab. You will be able to use these in your writing later in the week. We look forward to hearing your ideas this afternoon.
Day 8	You are going to plan a newspaper report of the events from the video.

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	You will find a planning sheet in your packs and on the school website. Remember to plan in your quotes using the speech bubbles from yesterday. Choose your favourite section of the plan to share this afternoon.
Day 9	Today you are going to use your plan to write your newspaper report. You can do this in your exercise book or on the computer. We would love to see your writing – feel free to ask an adult to take a picture and email it to us or prepare to share this afternoon.
Day 10	Please edit and redraft your narrative from yesterday. Firstly edit all of the spellings by reading backwards and then the punctuation by reading forwards. Choose one paragraph to redraft. Be prepared to share your original paragraph and your redrafted paragraph this afternoon.
