



Optional homework task - from now to 1 July

Our summer festival on 1 July this year has a carnival theme and we'll be holding a carnival mask parade on the day. As part of your homework over the next few weeks, children can create and decorate their own masks to bring to the festival on 1 July and display in our parade. We've set out some simple instructions below to help you get started. Have fun!



What you'll need

- Cardboard or empty cereal box
- Colouring pens/pencils or paint
- Glitter -PVA glue -Sticky tape
- Ribbon -Feathers -Scissors
- Any other decorative items

Step 1

Draw around the template below or create your own on cardboard

Step 2

Carefully cut out the mask and eyeholes using scissors - be careful and ask for help if this is a bit tricky

Step 3

Use your pens, colouring pencils, glue, glitter and other decorative items to decorate your mask

Step 4

When your mask is dry shake off any loose glitter and use sticky tape to attach any feathers or other items to the back of the mask

Step 5

When you have finished decorating your mask, use sticky tape to firmly attach ribbon to each side, on the back. Tie the ribbon together at the back of your head and you are ready to show off your creation

Step 6

Bring your fantastic masks along to our Summer Festival on 1 July for our carnival mask parade
