Maths

Complete the sheet we would normally stick in our books.

Remember: to convert a fraction to a decimal, you can divide the numerator by the denominator, e.g. $\frac{1}{8}$ as a decimal $> 1 \div 8$

Writing

Reading

Re-read the first **four paragraphs** from yesterday's extract – White Fang. Go to yesterday's remote learning page.

Today you should open the reading resource to help you write down some sentences about what you can **infer** about the wolf cub in **these paragraphs**. How does he feel BUT also why does he behave like he does? This is a bit like a reading comment you might include in your reading record.
