Maths

Complete the sheet we would normally stick in our books.

Remember: The relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. Think of all the learning from last week, e.g. $7/10 = 0.7 = 70\%$

You will need to probably convert what you are given (Varied Fluency) into all the same type, e.g. make all decimals, to help order them.
