You can complete these tasks in any order and only if you are feeling well enough to do so! Record them by typing or writing them in your home learning journal.

Maths

Have a look at the sheet for today. Remember that to find 10% of a number you need to divide it by 10.

If it helps, always draw out a % card to help with % calculations. For example:

100% =	<i>For example</i>	100% = 300
50% =	<i>with the</i>	50% = 150
25% =	<i>number 300</i>	25% = 75
10% =		10% = 30
5% =		5% = 15
1% =		1% = 3

Writing

Today we are planning a sequel to the story of The Viewer.

- (1) Read the rest of the story. Stop to look at the pictures too. They tell a story and could give ideas to how the book could continue.
- (2) Open the planning sheet document.
- (3) You can print this out or make notes in your jotter, as you go along.
Remember answer the questions on the left hand side of the plan to help and use the right hand side for ideas of how to make your writing sparkle.
- (4) Use the support example to give ideas – don't just copy this out!

Reading

Today is our silent reading session. Read your reading book at home and use today to make your quality, detailed comment. You could tell us about your character and your opinions of them and why. Maybe tell us what has just happened in the story and what might happen next. Add this to your reading record.

Spelling

Look at the spelling resource. Practise spelling some of words but really notice the spelling rule here too. Maybe try putting them into a sentence (you don't need to do all of them!) and look in a dictionary if you aren't too sure what they mean.
