

Spelling Homework 07.01.2022

In our spelling lessons next week, we will be learning to add the following suffixes:

-cial, -tial, -cially and -tially

The rule is that we normally add *-cial* if the root word ends with a vowel, and *-tial* if the root word ends with a consonant.

Task:

Write some examples of these words, making sure you spell them correctly. Use a dictionary (this could be online) to investigate the rule and see if you can find any exceptions (words that don't follow the rule). Write them down in your homework book!

You will be assessed on words with the *-cial, -tial, -cially* and *-tially* suffixes next week.

Your assessment next Friday (14th January) will be for you to write “fake news” headings – look below for examples – using some of the words we look at in the week and some you find for this homework.
