

ROUNDING NUMBERS SUPPORT SHEET

Here are some poems that might help you to round numbers.

Rounding Poem

Find your place
Look next door
5 or greater, add one more
All digits in front stay the same
All digits behind, zero's your name

Example:

Round to nearest ten

$\boxed{6} \underline{3} \rightarrow 60$

$\boxed{6} \underline{5} \rightarrow 70$

$5 \boxed{2} \underline{4} \rightarrow 520$

$5 \boxed{2} \underline{8} \rightarrow 530$

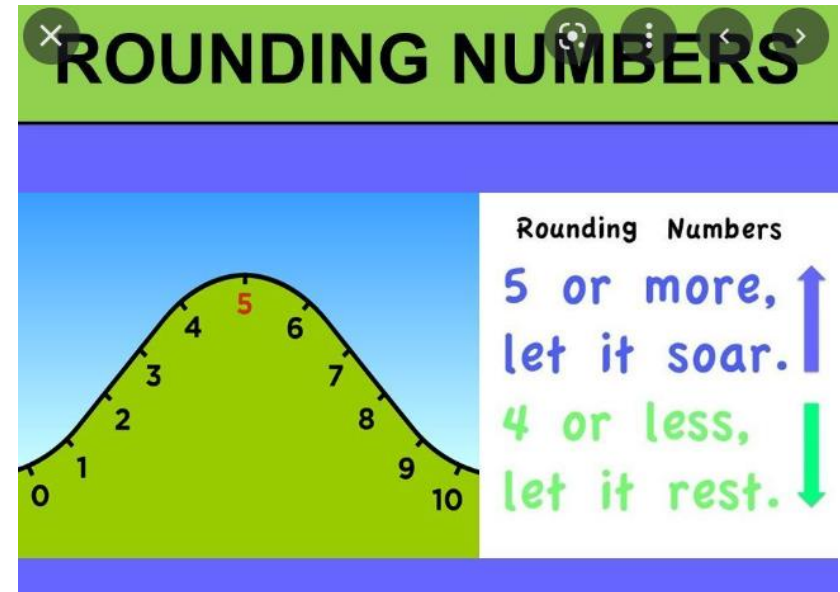
Round to nearest hundred

$\boxed{4} \underline{3} 5 \rightarrow 400$

$\boxed{4} \underline{6} 2 \rightarrow 500$

$7 \boxed{3} \underline{2} 8 \rightarrow 7300$

$7 \boxed{3} \underline{5} 6 \rightarrow 7400$



Always go to the column on the place value chart that you have been asked to round to....
Then go to the next door column, which will help you decide whether you need to round up or down!
