CORE SUBJECTS

Reading, Writing and Mathematical fluency are prioritised at Blackhorse through daily **PURPOSEFUL PRACTICE**.



ENQUIRY SUBJECTS

Two or more subjects may be taught within each enquiry, although a single subject will always be the 'lead subject'. Enquiry learning helps children understand how knowledge is connected between subjects. Enquiries are often linked to the local area, or story of our community, through reoccurring themes. They start with a big question and end with a challenge.



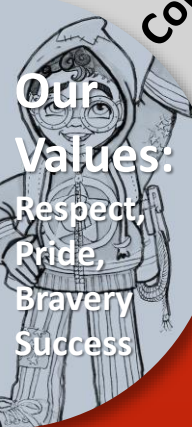
DISCRETE SUBJECTS

The remainder of the national curriculum subjects are taught discretely as the knowledge and skills taught do not link directly to other subject areas. However, these subjects may use the enquiry questions to provide a context for learning where it is useful to do so.
