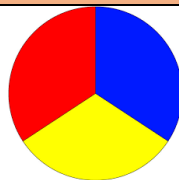
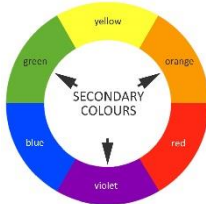
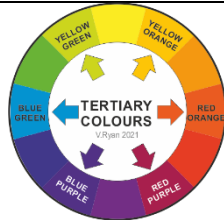
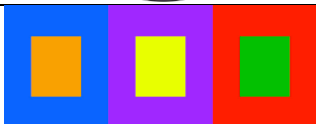
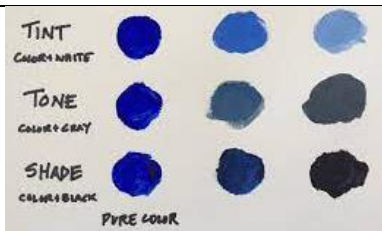


Vocabulary	Definition	Visual
KS1 and KS2		
Primary colours	Blue, Red and Yellow	
Secondary colours	Colours which are mixed using two Primary colours: Green, Purple, Orange	
Tertiary colours	Colours which are mixed using a primary colour and a secondary colours	
Complimentary colours	Colours which are opposite on the colour wheel – maximum contrast	
Analogous colours	Colours which are close to each other on the colour wheel – For Example: green and blue	
Tint	Adding white to a colour to make it lighter	
Tone	Adding grey to a colour to make it darker	
Shade	Adding black to a colour to make it darker	
Gradient	Moving through the colour wheel, from one colour into another	
Blending	A smooth transition from one colour to another	
Texture	Creating a surface which visually matches what it might feel like physically.	
Sculpture	A 3D artwork	
Form	In 3D art – the shape, height, width and length of a sculpture is it's form	
KS2 Only		
Directional strokes	Use your paintbrush repeatedly in one direction – not back and forth	

Contour lines	Following the lines of a shape	
Composition	What a complete piece of art looks like and where each element is positioned	
Aesthetic	What a piece of art looks like – usually down to personal taste	
Scale	How large or small an overall picture is	
Relative distances	The position of one object in relation to another. For example, where the ducks are compared to the house.	
Proportion	1) How big something is in relation to other objects in the picture. For example; The duck looks larger than the house because it is closer. 2) The size of a body part compared to another. For example: The size of the duck's head compared to its body	
Foreground	What appears closest to the viewer – The ducks	
Midground	What appears slightly further back – The first house	
Background	What appears to be the furthest away from the viewer – The second house	
Perspective	Where the artist is viewing the scene/subject from	
Negative space	Using the blank page to create a suggestion of something there
