Feedback Meeting with Mr Fry- discussion about Main/Mini Missions	Fed back to Mission Masters about my conversation with Mr Fry, regarding Main Missions and Mini Missions for this year.
Discussion about what to include in a letter to parents, regarding wet weather gear at playtimes	Mission Master thought the following were important to include in the letter: • Why are some children not bringing in coats? • Ask parents if they would be happy to send in wet weather gear to allow children to go out during wet play.
Games Group	The Mission Masters would like to set up a games group where older children play games with younger children. They believe this will support younger children's learning and develop confidence/social skills. We decided we would have a rota for Mission Masters to support this group and we will need to ask for games donations.
Food bins for KS2	Mission Masters suggested that the rubbish monitors could oversee bringing food bins out, currently KS2 food waste goes in main bins. Food bins will need to be ordered.
