Discussion points

Discuss Priorities for the Year	We discussed what we wanted to focus on for our Main Missions and Mini Mission this year. <u>Main Missions:</u> (Linked to personal effort) • Look into the factors that impact personal effort. Why are some children showing more personal effort than others? Can we put things in place to support this? Increase brain breaks in learning? Allow children to go out to play in wet weather by ensuring they have the right wet weather clothing.



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	<i>(Linked to Expert Tuition)</i> • What impact can older children have on younger children's learning/social and emotional skills? How can we further develop the Junior Reading Team that was set up last year? Older children to offer expert tuition to younger children, games, reading, etc. Mini Missions: • Feeling charts, worry monster, marble jar • Rubbish monitors • More bins, including recycling/food bins
