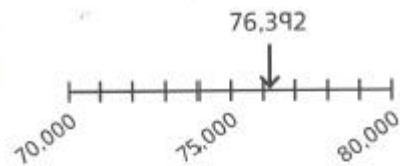
Below are some hints and tips that might help you.



5 or more let it soar, 4 or less let it rest

- a) The population of Zac's town is 76,392. To round to the nearest 10,000, look at the thousands.

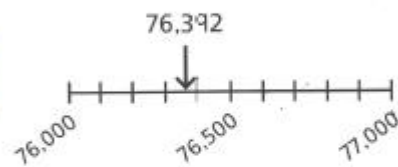
TTh	Th	H	T	O

There are 5 or more thousands, so 76,392 rounds up to 80,000.

To round to the nearest 1,000, look at the hundreds.

TTh	Th	H	T	O
7	6	3	9	2



There are fewer than 5 hundreds, so 76,392 rounds down to 76,000.

- b) The red part of the line shows all the numbers that would round to 500,000.



The minimum number of termites is 450,000.

550,000 rounds up to 600,000.
So the maximum number of termites is one fewer than this, 549,999.

I wonder why the guide has rounded the number of termites.
