At Blackhorse Primary, we understand that children from military families may face unique challenges, such as frequent relocations and the emotional impacts of parental deployment. To help support these children, we offer the **Service Pupil Premium (SPP)** – a government funding initiative aimed at providing additional support to service children.

What is the Service Pupil Premium?

The Service Pupil Premium is a government grant of **£320 per eligible child**. It is specifically for children whose parents are serving in the **British Armed Forces**. This funding helps us provide extra support to ensure that service children have the same opportunities to succeed as their peers.

How We Use the Service Pupil Premium

At Blackhorse Primary, we use the SPP to:

- Offer **emotional and pastoral support** for children whose parents are deployed or who have recently moved schools.
- Assist with **smooth transitions** when a child joins or leaves the school due to a parent's posting.
- Provide **additional learning resources** and opportunities to ensure each child reaches their full potential.



Eligibility

Your child may be eligible for the Service Pupil Premium if:

- One or both parents are currently serving in the **British Armed Forces**.
- Your child is enrolled at Blackhorse Primary and is of compulsory school age.

How to Apply
